

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Entry fees for all classes with the exception of show jumping: **MEMBERS £8, NON-MEMBERS £10.** See show jumping pages for entry fees for those classes.
2. Prize money for all classes with the exception of show jumping: **£10 & £8.** If less than 4 entries are forward for a class, prize money will be awarded to first place only. Show jumping: Rule 76.6 applies. **Prize money for Championship qualifiers will be withheld until the Championship.**
3. The Show Committee and the Landowners accept no liability for any occurrence on the Showground. Competitors and their supporters and friends are required to have regard for the Health and Safety of others. The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall, or anybody who suffers an injury whilst on the Showground, to report the fall/injury to the Show Secretary.
4. First Aid and Veterinary cover will be available on the Showground.
5. No exhibitor may enter or show a horse/pony under a judge who is known to have bred, sold, produced or received financial gain for that horse/pony. (Stud fees are exempt from financial gain).
6. Instructions from the Safety Officer are to be followed at all times. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the Showground.
7. Hard hats conforming to PAS015, EN1384 or ASTM F1163 with chin straps, properly adjusted and fastened, **MUST** be worn by everyone riding on the Showground. Random checks will be carried out. The wearing of hard hats is also advised in all youngstock classes.
8. Where there are less than three horses/ponies entered or forward for judging, classes may be amalgamated or cancelled at the Committee's discretion.
9. All grooms should be suitably dressed when assisting in the ring.
10. Horses/ponies are not permitted in public areas.
11. Horses tied to boxes **MUST NOT** be left unattended.
12. All rubbish must be removed and Horseboxes and Trailers must not be cleaned out on the Showground.
13. The horse walk to the collecting ring is for competitors and grooms only for the classes in progress. This is for safety reasons.
14. No entry will be accepted without the appropriate fee AND £2 per rider/handler per day for First Aid cover. **Competitors' numbers will be available on the day and passes will not be required for the 2008 show.**
15. Mainland entries should be prepared to book early on the ferries. Wightlink (0871 3761000) operates an Equestrian Special, which includes driver and up to three passengers.
16. Certain cups and trophies must remain with the Society; therefore competitors who win a cup may be presented with a replacement trophy. Cup winners are responsible for insuring cups while in their possession and for returning them in the condition that they were awarded in.
17. Dogs are to be kept on leads at all times.

1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 23 and 24 will be required for judging the Mini Championship. (Please note General Condition 2)

NUPAFEEED NPS BRITISH ISLES SUPREME RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the Champions and Reserves from the Working Hunter Ponies, Show Hunter Ponies and Mini Championships.

The qualifier to compete at the National Final to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show. In the event of a Supreme Champion having previously qualified the next appropriate pony not previously qualified will qualify. Qualification will go no lower than 3rd place.

Exhibitors do not need to be Members of the NPS to qualify for this Championship but will have to become an Adult/Showing Member in order to compete at the Final.

Ponies need not be registered with the NPS unless the Championship from which they qualify calls for registration.

MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND PONIES

Judge: Mrs A.P. Mills

The Vectis Perpetual Challenge Cup presented by Miss A M Reed will be awarded to the winner of the Vectis Stud Overall Mountain and Moorland Pony Championship.

NOTE: The Champion and Reserve prize winners from the In-Hand Championship and the Ridden Championship will be required for overall Mountain and Moorland Championship judging for the Vectis Perpetual Challenge Cup.

The Welsh Perpetual Challenge Cup (Y. Cwmpan Cymnreig) presented by the I.W. Welsh Society will be awarded to the best Welsh Cob (Section D). The two highest placed cobs in classes 26, 30 and 32 are eligible; handlers to provide and wear a yellow armband.

Special rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed yearling in classes 25 and 26. Handlers to provide and wear a white armband.

N.F.P.E.C. rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed New Forest Pony shown by an N.F.P.E.C. member in Mountain and Moorland classes. N.F.P.E.C. members should identify themselves with a green armband.

N.F.P.P.G. rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed "Forest Bred" New Forest Pony in Mountain and Moorland classes. Handlers are to provide and wear a blue armband.

NPS Silver Medal Championship Conditions

These Championships are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medals Rosettes are only awarded where the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced in the ring. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card cannot be produced in the ring, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided the Owner is a Member of the NPS and the membership card is produced in the ring. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can only be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 6-8th August 2008, providing they send to the NPS Secretariat the relevant entry fee and qualification card.

NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the final.
