Regulations:

Entries may be restricted at the discretion of the organisers for safety reasons. All turnouts must be accompanied by a groom.

Grooms and passengers must be over 11 years old on the day of the show. Young drivers must have a groom 18 years old or over on the day of the show.

The following two classes are a qualifier for the 2009 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following Type-Sections disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class will qualify for the 2009 Semi-Finals. The Championship will follow the Semi-Final.

b - Single non-hackney-type (excluding purebred Registered Welsh) over 13.2hh.

c - Single non-hackney-type (excluding purebred Registered Welsh) -13.2hh & under.

h – Single registered Mountain and Moorland (excluding purebred registered Welsh – 13.2hh & under

l – Single turnout driven to a two-wheeled exercise vehicle
